Ten reasons to choose e2e

- 1 It's not like school or college - *small groups, more support from tutors, treated like adults*
- 2 It can improve your chances of getting a job and helps you to make up your mind about what you want to do
- 3 It can lead to an apprenticeship - *administration, motor vehicle, hairdressing, retail, warehousing or customer service*
- 4 You can get real work experience with a local company
- 5 It gives you a chance to get qualifications for the job you want to do - NVQ/VRQ in Motor Vehicle, Hairdressing or Retail, Key Skills or IT qualifications

Quest's Entry to Employment (e2e) is a training programme for young people between the ages of 16 - 18. The programme is for young people who:

- want to get an apprenticeship or job but left school with no, or very few, qualifications
- would like to work and train for a qualification at the same time

The aim of Quest's e2e programme is to help you improve your chances of getting a job, join an apprenticeship programme or enrol on a further education course. As well as learning about your chosen area of work, you will also learn other skills to help you find and keep a job and improve your lifeskills.

Following successful completion of the six week e2e induction you will be offered the opportunity to achieve qualifications related to your chosen area of employment. We will also look for a suitable work placement where you can continue to work towards your qualifications.
